ALLISON SLEISTER-HAMILTON VS. THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION; EIGHTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT, CASE NO. 2015-CA-1746 (B)

The City Commission authorize the City Attorney to represent the City in the case styled Allison Sleister-Hamilton vs. The City of Gainesville, a municipal corporation; Eighth Judicial Circuit, Case No. 2015-CA-1746.

On May 13, 2015, the City was served with a Summons and Complaint filed by Allison Sleister-Hamilton. Allison Sleister-Hamilton alleges that she was involved in an automobile accident with a City vehicle on March 25, 2014 at the intersection of SE 1st Street and SE 2nd Avenue, in Gainesville. Allison Sleister-Hamilton claims to have suffered bodily injury, including permanent injury, as well as aggravation of a preexisting condition, pain and suffering of both a physical and mental nature, disability, physical impairment, disfigurement, mental anguish, inconvenience, loss of capacity for the enjoyment of life, loss of income, loss of earning capacity, expense of medical and nursing care and treatment, and loss of ability to lead and enjoy a normal life. Ms. Sleister-Hamilton seeks money damages in excess of \$15,000.00.
