RESOLUTION OF THE **CITY COMMISSION** OF THE **CITY OF** GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE **BUDGET** FOR THE **CITY** FINAL OF **GAINESVILLE GAINESVILLE REGIONAL UTILITIES FOR** THE **FISCAL YEAR** D/B/A**BEGINNING** SEPTEMBER 30, 2018; PROJECTING REVENUES AND OCTOBER 1, 2017 AND ENDING **FINAL BUDGET** PAY **PERSONAL** ADOPTING Α TO FOR **SERVICES** EXPENSES, OPERATING AND **MAINTENANCE EXPENSES** AND **OTHER** EXPENSES, FOR CAPITAL OUTLAY, AND FOR DEBT **SERVICE** REQUIREMENTS; AND **PROVIDING** IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.
