### THIRD BUDGET AMENDMENT TO THE FY 2017 GENERAL GOVERNMENT FINANCIAL AND OPERATING PLAN BUDGET (B)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA; RELATING TO ITS GENERAL GOVERNMENT BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2016 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2017; AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 160305, AS AMENDED BY RESOLUTION NO. 160759 AND RESOLUTION NO.160955, BY MAKING CERTAIN ADJUSTMENTS TO THE GENERAL GOVERNMENT FINANCIAL AND OPERATING PLAN BUDGET; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

The purpose of this amendment is to accurately reflect and incorporate into the City's FY 2017 General Government budget those transactions and activities that were not anticipated during the budget process.

All of the recommended changes are funded either by increases in revenue budgets, decreases in expenditure budgets, or decreases in appropriate fund balances.

The City Commission adopt the proposed resolution.
