Title: Quasi-Judicial - Historic Property Tax Exemption - 430 NE 9th Avenue (B)

Ordinance No. 180412

An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, finding that property located at 430 NE 9th Avenue, Gainesville, Florida, as more specifically described in this ordinance, qualifies for an ad valorem tax exemption for historic properties; granting an exemption from ad valorem tax for certain improvements beginning January 1, 2019, and continuing for 10 years under certain conditions; authorizing the Mayor and the Clerk of the Commission to sign the Historic Preservation Property Tax Exemption Covenant between the property owner and the City; providing a severability clause; providing a

repealing clause; and providing an effective date.
