Resolution to the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for a Construction and Maintenance Agreement (CMA) for the Area of SR 26 (West University Ave) from Gale Lemerand Drive to NW 14th St. (B)

This item is a request to adopt a Resolution to grant FDOT a CMA related to traffic calming and improving pedestrian safety.

FDOT proposes Financial Project Number (“FIN”) 207658-2-52-01, which includes the coating of all new and existing poles and mast arms, controller cabinets, pedestrian poles, and pedestrian head(s) (collectively referred to as “structures”) with a colored epoxy coating.

Strategic Recommendation: Goal 3: A Great Place to Live & Experience

There is no initial, fiscal impact with this request, as construction will be performed and funded by FDOT. There will be maintenance costs every 8 to 10 years estimated at \$8,000.00 to \$12,000.00, per signalized intersection, depending on the structure sizes.

The City Commission adopt a Resolution authorizing the execution of the Construction and Maintenance Agreement with FDOT and authorize the City Manager to execute all necessary documents, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality.
