TEODOSIA ALARCON V. CITY OF GAINESVILLE; EIGHTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT, CASE NO. 2016 -CA-2531 (B)

The City Commission authorize the City Attorney to represent the City in the case styled Teodosia Alarcon v. City of Gainesville; Eighth Judicial Circuit, Case No. 2016-CA-2531.

On November 2, 2016, the City was served with a Summons and Complaint filed by Teodosia Alarcon in the Circuit Court. Teodosia Alarcon alleges that on or about January 27, 2015, she tripped and fell on a sidewalk in front of 611 North Main Street. Teodosia Alarcon claims to have suffered bodily injury, and resulting pain and suffering, disability, disfigurement, mental anguish and pain, and aggravation of a previously existing condition and has incurred substantial medical expenses for treatment and care, past, present and future. Ms. Alarcon seeks money damages in excess of \$15,000.00.
